Hello,

I'm writing to submit my view of that the proposed dam is ineffective for actually controlling flooding and ecologically destructive on top of that.

There are much more effective alternatives for flood mitigation than building in flood prone areas and attempting to remake a landscape that has been doing this for millenenia. This is short sited folly in a time of dam removals.

Most importantly however is the earusre of some of the most important spawning habitat in the basin for threatened anadromous fish species (including Chinook and steelhead). This upper elevation area also will serve as a more critical cold water refuge for these species in the face of climate change. It cannot do this in the form of a massive clear cut that is then flooded. Do not approve this dam.
