The Upper Chehalis river above the Skookumchuck and Elk Creek, is the last true wild steelhead river in our area. I believe this is important enough to find another alternative than building in the PeEll Canyon.

The flood plain from the Newakum to Porter has very little elevation drop. I feel like the river channels and the flow to grays harbor, could be improved. This would provide a major impact to the current flood water situation, especially around I5 in Centralia. Please keep the Upper Chehalis Wild. It's the only Natural Egg Bank in our Valley.
