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Would the cap and invest program usage by TransAlta not conflict with the PSD air quality permit requirements, including the implementation of the Best Available Control Technology (BACT) to minimize emissions and maintain clean air resources? There could be an over-reliance on the usage of cap and invest instead of realistically mitigating the increase in VOC and CO2 emissions slated to occur.

While a new clean energy grant program will be established and it is noted to be available to residents; what will be the percentages of individual resident financial assistance versus local agencies, tribes, and 501(c)(3)'s? The concern here is that larger organizations will overshadow local individuals who are more heavily affected by project impacts.
