I reviewed the Small Use Court Claim form for our 1/2 acre property in Whatcom county. Section 5 asks for the street address of property with well - number and street, city, county, and zip code. The city associated with our street address, Sedro Woolley, is located 20 miles away from and in a different county, Skagit, than our actual property location not in any city in Whatcom county. Is that going to be a problem to list our address using "Sedro Wooley, Whatcom, WA, 98284"? (It's a federal post office delivery thing...)

Also, in Section 8 - Signatures - Signed at (city and state): since we do not live in or near any city should we just use "Whatcom County, WA" since we cannot state that we signed in Sedro Woolly (in a different city and county from where we live)?

Your clarifications for these sections are greatly appreciated as we would like to be as concise as possible filling out this legal document.
