The proposed definition of "active storage" does not seem to align with common dam safety industry. As currently written, the definition of active storage seems to better align with "reservoir capacity". USSD defines active storage as "The volume of the reservoir that is available for some use such as power generation, irrigation, flood control, water supply, etc. The bottom elevation is the minimum operating level." While reservoir capacity is total storage contained by the dam, below a designated elevation.
