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I believe there are errors in the Example 2 table on the top of Page 22. The Year 1 total CIR sums to 28.71 (not 20.24) and the Year 4 total CIR sums to 25.86 (not 19.43). This impacts the 2 highest CU years.

Also I have some confusion on the Example 3 calculations. Can you please explain why we use the formula " $CU = Total\ ET - Pe$ " and not " $CIR = Total\ ET - Pe$ ", as outlined on Page 6.
