Hello, I have spent many years working with residents along the I-5 and 99 freight corridors and have directly seen the impact freight air pollution has in the neighborhoods, especially in Georgetown and South Park. Kids have more asthma attacks than in other neighborhoods, and there are multiple data reports from the UW that this is directly connected to diesel emissions from large trucks. Courageous agencies like Port of Seattle are leading important investments into electrification of the fleet but it's not enough.
