Re: Comments on Rulemaking for Clean Fuels Standard (WAC 173-424 and 173-455-150)

Dear Dept. of Ecology,

SRECTrade, Inc. (dba Xpansiv Managed Solutions) respectfully **recommends that Ecology prioritize developing a Tier 1 Hydrogen calculator as soon as feasible, given the hydrogen lookup pathways are no longer available per recent amendments to the CFS.** Completing this calculator will align with Ecology's stated goal in this rulemaking process to "improve implementation of the rule" as well as "aligning with other low carbon fuel programs".

CARB's Tier 1 hydrogen calculator (which has been available for several years) provides an available basis for completing Ecology's calculator. The grid-CI score in CARB's tool can be replaced with a reference value of the utility CI score, which Ecology is already publishing annually, to make the calculator Washington-specific and more accurate representation of GHG emissions. Completing a Tier 2 pathway may be time and cost prohibitive for nascent hydrogen projects, and may not provide a significantly more accurate CI score than a utility-specific electrolysis Tier 1 calculation. The inclusion of HD-HRI capacity crediting in the program indicates the importance of supporting hydrogen infrastructure as a heavy-duty vehicle fueling solution in Washington; making a Tier 1 pathway available and attainable will align with this priority.

We applaud the Washington legislature's actions to strengthen the ambition of the program and viability of the CFS market by implementing stricter CI standards. Additionally, Ecology's work to ensure the GREET model reflects Washington's specific fuel supply parameters remains important to ensure integrity of the greenhouse gas reductions credited in the program. These steps, along with facilitating Tier 1 hydrogen participation, send strong signals of support for ongoing transportation decarbonization in the state.
