The current prohibition on gas drilling and fracking was put in place in 2010 by the Commission based on the determination that natural gas projects, individually or cumulatively, will have a substantial impact on the River's water resources.

Since that time, scientific analysis and studies, public health statistics, the experience of communities where fracking is occurring, and government records show that the impacts of gas and oil development are significantly harming the environment including our water, air, habitats and communities' health, despite regulatory controls.

The Commission is responsible for safeguarding the water resources of the Delaware River Watershed and the water supply for 17 million people. In the face of the weight of evidence that gas and oil development has substantial adverse impacts and is therefore unsafe and unsustainable, it is incumbent upon the Commission to take action. We ask you, the Governors of the four states that flow to the Delaware River and tributary streams – Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey and Delaware - and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as the federal representative, to immediately adopt a ban on all oil and gas development in the Delaware River Watershed.

Since 2010 the Delaware River Basin Commission (DRBC) has prohibited permitting for natural gas extraction projects in the Delaware River Basin while they study its potential impacts on water resources, a *de-facto* moratorium that does not allow permits to be issued until natural gas regulations are adopted.

Since that time, scientific analysis and studies, public health statistics, the experience of communities where fracking is occurring, and government records show that the impacts of gas and oil development are significantly harming the environment including our water, air, habitats and communities' health, despite regulatory controls. The overwhelming weight of evidence supports that shale gas cannot be extracted or developed safely with current technology.

There seems to be new interest on the part of DRBC staff to rekindle the development of gas development regulations, which would lift the current moratorium. We must tell the DRBC that NOW IS THE TIME to enact a permanent ban on all gas development, including drilling and fracking, in the Delaware River Watershed.
