To the Delaware River Basin Commissioners -

Thank you for your attention to the Delaware River Basin, and to the quality of the drinking water in that region. I'm writing as a concerned Citizen with friends in this area. I urge you to ban fracking wastewater and produced water importation, transportation, storage, processing, and discharge in the Delaware River Basin.

It is quite serious that fracking leads to water contamination. It's shocking that of the "over 36,000" reported spills from the oil and gas industry from January 2006 through April 2012, almost all the spills occurred beyond well sites. Of course many were oil spills from pipelines, but I was quite surprised to learn that spills from transporting wastes were not included in the contamination analysis conducted by EPA. Wastes from well sites where fracking is not banned will continue to threaten the Delaware River Basin.

We cannot afford to jeopardize the health of our fellow citizens and continuously ruin the environment that we depend on. Please think wisely and humanely as you consider this life and environment altering decision.
