The proposed DRBAC Regulations regarding fracking activity on the Delaware River are totally unacceptable.

I am not alone in my sentiments. As you know, there have been four public hearings so far having to do with the proposed DRBC regulations. I attended one of these in Philadelphia on January 25. Out of 51 people who spoke until meeting time ran out, only two spoke in favor of the new regulations. 49 people, including a Pennsylvania representative, several university professors, a former science teacher, representatives from environmental groups like the Sierra Club and the Clean Air Council, attorneys, Catholic nuns and many, many private residents, spoke out vehemently and passionately for a full ban on fracking, or anything tied to fracking in our precious Delaware River.

The logic is very simple. If fracked water is allowed back into the Delaware, the Delaware will become polluted. It is not okay to play around with our finite water resource!! This IS a matter of life and death.
