To the Members of the Commission:

I urge you to prohibit any dumping of frack wastewater into the Delaware River. Frack wastewater harms us. Frack wastewater has levels of radioactivity hundreds or thousands of times higher than federal drinking water standards (Drilling Down, Ian Urbina, 2011). In addition, in a study of more than 1,021 chemicals used in fracking fluid or produced during fracking, scientists found that 781 lack basic toxicity data. Of the remaining 240, 157 are developmental or reproductive toxins (January 2016, Yale School of Public Health).

In summary, don't poison the well: more specifically, don't poison a river that provides drinking water for 16 million people.
