We need a moratorium on fracking in the DE Valley Basin. At this time, the DRBC's proposed regulations allow dumping of fracking waste in the river basin. This highly toxic waste material includes hundreds of "exempt chemicals." Radioactive materials are also a part of the toxic mix that will be dumped into the river. The "proposed treatment" cannot remove radioactive particles. Additionally, the fracking industry will be pumping-out fresh water directly from the watershed for use in drilling operations elsewhere. This is a direct threat to public health which can only be eliminated by imposing a permanent ban on fracking in the Delaware River Watershed Region.
