Two comments:

- 1.) Administrative decisions by the Executive Director must be explicitly subject to up or down votes by the DRBC Commissioners (including but not limited to the power to decide whether or not a change to a project is "material").
- 2.) Rather than removing references to the Freedom of Information Act from its rules, DRBC rules should be governed by the most liberal FOI laws that govern Federal agencies or in any of the four watershed states (NY, NJ, PA, DE) or Federal.
