Please deny this permit to allow discharge in to Boysen Reservoir. It makes no sense that the material will become diluted as it passes through the reservoir. The sediment containing the sulfates and chlorides will settle out within the tributaries and within the reservoir. In the low water years the toxicity will be worse because the dilution factor will be less. Boysen Reservoir will become more toxic and with decreasing water quality as the time progresses. The permit applicant should be required to clean up the effluent before the Boysen tributary drainages and before reaching Boysen Reservoir.
