The water that is being discharged has been ran through a separator to separate hydrocarbons and then through a big knockout system which cleans the water even more, then it goes to a pit for a final cleaning before being discharged. The water that is being discharged is just salty and nothing else, it is just like the water in all the surrounding creeks like alkali creek, bad water and poison creek. Those creeks didn't get there names for being clean.
