Finally from a voters prospective, one family vs everyone downstream. It doesn't make any sense why this is an issue.

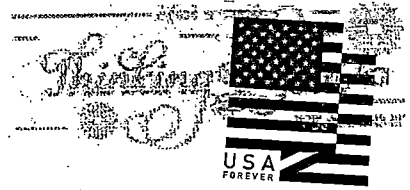
