I grew up in British Columbia where now the wolf problem has become so severe that even the Native Indians are killing them . All you have to do is read their hunting regulations and see what they are doing . Since I live 5 miles from the B.C. border I know that Mr & Mrs Wolf do not check in at the customs office when they cross into WA State ! I believe the lack of control on the wolfs was why we lost are small Caribou herd . I believe that if a Legal hunt is not instituted that hunters will operate by the Law of the 3 S,S . SHOOT , SHOVEL & SHUT-UP . I think that as long as the big city crowd controls the policy we will see our problem only worsen . Thank You .
