1. I did not authorize the use of my tax dollars for the killing of wolves.
2. The your current plan of killing wolves is not based on the available scientific information.

4. Wolves have a "grandfather" right to be here - they were here long before humans and cattle and other livestock.
5. Wolves are not fully recovered in our state.
6. Livestock should not be allowed to graze in areas where wolves are attempting to recover. Changes need to be made.
7. You should be listening carefully and adhering to the policies of people with scientific information on wolf recovery.
8. Your department's killing of wolves has deprived Washington state of the opportunity to be a leader in the nation for wolf recovery.
