LISA, I would like to comment on the wolf plan after wolves are delisted in Washington by the state and federal governments. I feel this planning is moving way to slow if we are going to save our game animals from wolves. Our moose herds are already really hurt from wolves, the elk where I live are either getting killed, or are moving down to private land where this is becoming another problem for some people. That moves to predation permits for the removal of our cow elk, which we need to sustain our herds. In eastern Washington this plan should have been in place long ago. By the time Washington has a plan in place to kill some wolves, there will be a court battle that will delay removing wolves longer. Our game animals will be totally screwed up by then. The wolf is not a trophy animal to me, if there was a season on them I would buy
