To update oil spill planning to be more effective and sensible, more effort is needed to develop objective measures of oil spill cleanup technique efficacy, based on field experiments in actual Alaska conditions. Skimmers in particular need to be put through their paces to determine the efficacy of various different designs and strategies. The results of such characterization would doubtless both reveal opportunities to reduce costs and also weaknesses in our response planning that need to be addressed.
