If you like to learn more, the United States Navy has been using microreactors to power its submarines for decades. Their report "Occupational Radiation Exposure from U.S. Naval Nuclear Plants and their Support Facilities" published in May 2021 provides compelling evidence about the safety of this technology. A choice excerpt: "The reason low-dose [radiation] studies cannot be conclusive is that the risk, if it exists at these low levels, is too small to be seen in the presence of all the other risks of life."
