It is great to see more of a focus on waste reduction and reuse to reduce the amount of waste going into metro area landfills. It would definitely help to incentivize this work through grants/funding.

Regarding the goal of "Commit to standardized outreach and education" -- I think this is very important. I'm an MRC in Dakota County so I am part of outreach/education efforts. It would be really helpful for me (and all MRCs in all metro counties) to be able to use standard messages that apply everywhere in the metro area.

I hope to see this optional goal adopted -- Adopt an ordinance with a mandatory consumer charge for take-out single-use cups, containers and utensils. There is a major need to reduce single use cups and foodservice items. It would also help to encourage and increase reuse by consumers.

I am glad to see the goal to establish a reuse location for residential drop-off and pick-up. And incentivize deconstruction over landfilling demolition debris. It would be great if drop-off options for homeowners could be added into (or nearby) each of the county environmental centers.
