Mandatory pre-processing does not make a lot of sense. Transfer stations already transfer recyclables, C&D, MSW. Some are already going to recycling facilities. Pre-processing would be redundant. Space is too limited. For example: Ramsey/Washington had to add space for blue bag. Malcom transfer station does not have room to do pre-processing.

Don't need any more wish-cycling. Already trying to educate consumers about what should go in recycling bins. Very little value to putting in preprocessing material that should not have recyclables in it.

There are lots of strategies in the plan that will result in very little environmental benefit. But will come at a much greater cost. It will require people to pay more and it may not be better for the environment. Could mean additional trucks and additional impacts. Could be burdensome for people who can afford it the least.
