• In addition to what is proposed, may I suggest public education regarding indoor worm composting. When living in California, we had a large, attractive worm composter on legs and enjoyed the "black gold" and "worm tea" worms produce. We used it for our indoor plants and outside garden. There are also smaller countertop models available.

• Explore and encourage serious studies into using Fungi that can break down unrecyclable plastic in the landfills. I understand that Engyodontium Album and Aspergillus Terreus can break down plastic in just 140 days.
