I support the MPCA's efforts to identify 2,395 will rice producing waters and to add 20 additional wild rice waters impaired due to sulfate, although the MPCA should add Dark Lake to the list of impaired waters.

My biggest concern is that there is no commitment to actually reduce the sulfate and mercury pollution in these waters. That is crucial.
