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Past failure to enforce our sulfate standards does not imply current and future violations are allowable.

Citizen advocates and science groups have - and continue to - provide water sampling and monitoring. Their data leaves no doubt of point sources - and the degradation process - of wild rice waters.

Dark Lake must be added to the 2024 list of impaired waters.

Remediation cannot be executed without thorough, data-driven inclusion of all waters impaired by sulfate pollution.
