As a physician with a biology background, a member of the Land and Water committees of the Wild River Conservancy and Sierra Club and a Minnesota citizen concerned about preserving our water quality I would like to make suggestions regarding the feed lot permit revision.

I would suggest the following to limit feedlot generated manure contamination of our waters:

- 1 Apply manure only to growing crops (certainly no winter application)
- 2 Plant a cover crop within 14 days of manure application
- 3 A perennial crop needs to to be applied for 2-5 years

I hope that the MPCA will take a stand for Minnesota citizens and make these changes
