I was very surprised to hear that MPCA was unaware that Washington County put in a drainage culvert from Goggins Lake to South School Section Lake back several years ago when water levels were very high and flooding Keller Ave, I'm a property owner on School Section. Another concern is water levels with three wells on one property. With global warming we are constantly in drought conditions, I'm concerned our Lake and others close by will have the same effects as White Bear Lake. I'm also confused as to how a construction site of this magnitude can be built in an area that according to the Met Council is to remain rural through 2040. As a land owner 70 acres I have been limited to one house per 10 acres this project far surpasses what the Met Council dictates to all of the landowners who live here, however that's also why we are here, it's to remain rural.
