Thank you for hosting the informative meeting on Tuesday. It was exciting to see how knowledgeable and passionate everyone at MPCA is about their job.

My hope is that you will become more knowledgeable about exactly what LCA is proposing to build and the area that it will affect. This is NOT a suburban neighborhood. If drinking water becomes contaminated I can't buy or boil water for my livestock. Most of my immediate neighbors are either farming or raising livestock for food and we are dependent on clean water. I urge MPCA to conduct a thorough environmental impact study of this area. There are numerous wetlands including a wetland with cattails on the LCA property. The headwaters of Brown's Creek are less than 3/4 mile from the LCA property. Surface runoff from their 2 parking lots, cleaning products entering the aquifer and pesticides from their sports fields are major concerns. A building of this size and scope belongs in an area that has the infrastructure to support it, not in a farming community.
