Although a voluntary approach may be desirable, it thus far has not been significantly effective. Could it be proposed that a voluntary approach be continued for crop land primarily used to produce food or animal feed but impose mandatory requirements for crop land use to produce fuel (ethanol, biodiesel, jet fuel, etc.).
