The Ford Site was previously listed on the State's Superfund Permanent List of Priorities (PLP). Ford cleaned up Areas A and B on the main Ford Site to allow for sale to developers. The Area C dump site has not been remediated. The MPCA should reopen the Superfund process for Area C, require a permanent remedy in accordance with the law, and hold Ford liable for the full cost. The fact that MPCA was negligent in not holding Ford accountable for Area C full cleanup previously, should not relieve Ford from full accountability now. Ford has never contested its Superfund liability for Area C, dating back to its original PLP listing. Permanent means permanent until permanently remedied to comply with the Superfund law.
