Immediately DEMAND a full ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT from Riverview Dairy.

Advancing any permit for Riverview Dairy without full understanding of the frighteningly DEVASTATING GROUNDWATER and WATER-QUALITY risk is unconscionable.

The Riverview Dairy controlled animal feeding operation would be nearly DOUBLE the size of the LARGEST current operation in our state. It's potential environmental DESTRUCTION is MASSIVE.

Riverview would use HUNDREDS of MILLIONS of gallons of water per year.

Riverview would dump HUNDREDS of MILLIONS of gallons of liquid manure and wastewater per year PLUS TENS of THOUSANDS of TONS of solid manure.

The DNR has NO SURVEY or completed County Geologic ATLAS for Stevens County, so aquifer and groundwater resources are UNKNOWN.

Nearest waters—the Pomme de Terre River and a nearby unnamed creek—are already COMPROMISED and listed as IMPAIRED.

REQUIRE a full ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT from Riverview Dairy immediately.
