The Riverview expansion should require a full EIS.

GHG testing and estimating that was done as part of the Environmental Assessment Worksheet was based only on the number of cows they intend to add, not including the base amount of cows they already have. This leaves an incomplete picture of the true costs to the environment, the community, the water, and the land.

Riverview has a recent history of manure spills in western Minnesota.

The Environmental Assessment Worksheet prepared for this project claims that the project will overall reduce GHG emissions because they will not be using anhydrous ammonia on the fields that have manure being spread on them. This grossly undercounts the true emissions of an operation of this scale and must be reviewed further in a full Environmental Impact Statement.
