My name is Dustin Walsh, and I farm in Swift County MN. I grow corn, soybeans, sugar beets and alfalfa, and our family has worked with Riverview for over 20 years.

I receive manure from the dairy as part of my nutrient management plan. Before any application, my fields are soil tested and manure is applied at agronomic rates following state guidelines. From my experience, this is a structured and responsible process.

Manure has improved my soil health, increased organic matter, and reduced my need for commercial fertilizer. The dairy also provides a reliable local market for crops like silage and alfalfa. That partnership supports the long-term sustainability of my farm.

I understand this expansion is being reviewed through the state's environmental process. Based on my firsthand experience working within those rules, I am confident the project can continue to operate responsibly.
