- . The impact that an increase in fugitive dust emissions would have on your health, particularly if you have respiratory issues or other pre-existing conditions
- .The impact increased fugitive dust emissions would have on your pets, horses, and all wildlife (deer, elk, turkeys, hummingbirds, etc.)
- .The impact that increased fugitive dust will have on your property specifically the natural landscape, the abundant ingenious wildlife, or garden, or chard or cultivated landscaping you may have in your property.

- .The fallacy of assuming meteorological and topographical conditions from the Holloman AFB area accurately represent the winds, overall weather and terrain of the Alto area.
- .The increased noise level and activity would have a negative impact on wild life.
