Subject: Request for Public Hearing Determination for Air Quality Permit Application for Targa Northern Delaware, LLC – Road Runner Gas Processing Plant (GPP)

The Air Quality Bureau received 4,499 written public comment emails during the 30-day public comment period. The emails requested a public hearing regarding Air Quality Permit No. 7200M4.

20.2.72.206.A.4 and B NMAC provide for the opportunity for public comment and for a public hearing if the Department Secretary determines there is significant public interest. The application was received by the Bureau on December 16, 2022, and ruled complete January 13, 2023. The Public Notice was published January 19, 2023, with the comment period ending February 18, 2023. The Bureau received the 4,499 comment letters within the 30-day comment period. If a hearing is approved, the anticipated timing for the hearing would be Spring 2023.

The comment letter, provided to the public by WildEarth Guardians, focused on the “increase of smog-forming, toxic, and climate-destroying air pollution” that the permit would create. It should be noted that the comments were received without the draft permit documents and analysis being available for review. An example comment email letter is attached.

Based on these comments and "significant public interest," the Bureau is recommending that a public hearing be held on the air permit application.
