**Subject:** Request for Public Hearing Determinations for Air Quality Permit Applications for Targa Northern Delaware, LLC – Frac Cat and Big Lizard Compressor Stations

The AQB received written 3 public comment emails during the 30-day public comment period. The commenters requested a public hearing regarding the reopening of Air Quality Operating Permit Nos. P288, Frac Cat Compressor Station, and P289, Big Lizard Compressor Station.

Prior to issuing initial TV permits P288 and P289 on April 16, 2022 and on July 29, 2022, respectively, the AQB received comments from WildEarth Guardians (WEG). The comments did not request a hearing. AQB subsequently submitted a Response to Comments to WEG and to EPA and issued the permits. WEG petitioned an objection to the issuance of the TV Permits to EPA. On November 16, 2022, EPA issued an Order, granting two claims. AQB reopened the two permits and revised them to resolve the EPA Order. As required, AQB re-ran the public notice for both the permits on April 4, 2023 for Frac Cat and April 5, 2023 for Big Lizard.

AQB received 3 comments during the re-public noticing, primarily expressing concern regarding the enforceability of the startup, shutdown, maintenance, and malfunction emissions condition, the ozone concentrations in southeast New Mexico, and compliance with the National Ambient Air Quality Standards. The letters also requested a public hearing regarding the revised proposed permits.

20.2.70.401.A and B NMAC provide for the opportunity for public comment and for a public hearing if the Department Secretary determines there is significant public interest. If a hearing is approved, the anticipated timing for the hearing would be Fall 2023.

The WEG comments are similar to the WEG comments received for permits which went to public hearing in October 2021, November 2021, and October 2022.
