Re: Broadway Transfer Station

Please deny the permit for the Broadway Transfer Station. Yes, these types of facilities are necessary but Mountain View is already an overburdened community. Our water and air have already been compromised more than any other part of the metropolitan area by the industry and traffic that has been permitted thus far. Additionally, our infrastructure is inadequate for the current volume and has not been maintained.

Heavy trucks are already using 2nd street south of Rio Bravo to avoid Broadway. Desert is constantly lined with tank trucks waiting for entry to the petroleum facility. 400 more trucks a day would be a disaster for our residential traffic and add pollution to the valley air.

Many areas have only one way in and one way out and any type of accident or fire like we had last week may create a life threatening situation for local residents.

Please consider families that have lived in this area for generations, our school children at Mountain View, who already have the highest incidence of asthma of any school in the district, and the fact that we cannot adequately handle the current industrial/commercial impact in the area.

Please deny the permit.
