I am in strong opposition to the issuing of a Solid Waste permit to any company to open a Transfer Station on Broadway.

I have worked with the farmers in this community for many years to grow healthy produce for the families of Albuquerque. So much polluting industry is already located in and around the Mountain View community. I regularly drove to work through a cloud of dust and air pollution from the concrete factory across the railroad tracks from Mountain View Elementary! I used to see regular flaring from the industry at Broadway and Rio Bravo, now I just see the wavy disturbance in the air from the heat and other releases from this industry.

The transfer station would bring 400 large diesel trucks, hauling waste from outside of the county, into the neighborhood DAILY!
