The state is attempting to impose onerous labeling requirements on all product categories, including those exempted from the legislation. The only basis for these labeling requirements appears to be the language in the bill saying "The board may: (1) adopt rules to carry out the provisions of the Per- and Poly-Fluoroalkyl Substances Protection Act, including requiring the labeling of products in English and Spanish"

However, to impose labeling requirements on product categories that were chosen to be exempt is not making "rules to carry out the provisions" of the Act. The Act was written to exempt certain product categories, and therefore any rulemaking should follow suit.
