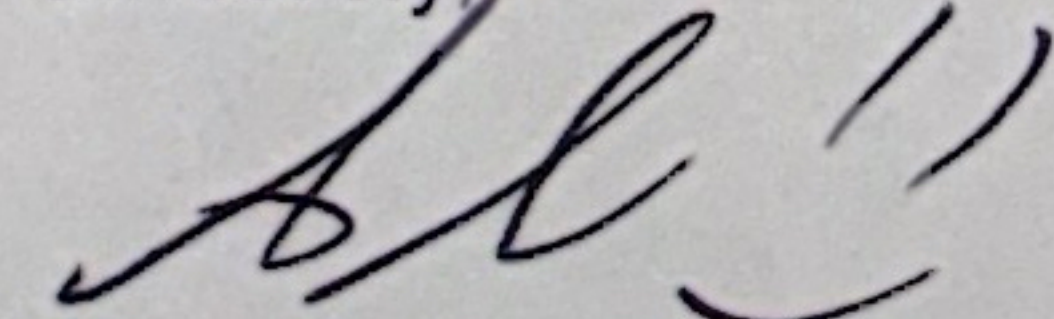
Project Jupiter also sends an important signal to other companies evaluating New Mexico for expansion or relocation. Demonstrating that the state can responsibly permit and support
