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Water and the health of our communities are more important than data centers. If you will not live long enough to feel the repercussions of your actions you should not get a say in our future. OUR PLANET AND PEOPLE WILL ALWAYS BE MORE VALUABLE THAN ANY BLOOD MONEY YOU CAN RECIEVE! PEOPLE ARE ALREADY SUFFERING. THERE IS ALREADY DATA PROVING WHY DATA CENTERS ARE DANGEROUS. YOU CANNOT DRINK MONEY!

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably. The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County. If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
