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I'm writing directly to you because I think you should hear this clearly.

You are building a hyperscale data center in a desert with a broken water system. Elephant Butte Lake is at 13% capacity. The regional utility serving your site has failed arsenic tests and is currently being sued by the state. And you need nearly one million gallons of water a day.

Your natural gas microgrid appears to exploit a loophole in New Mexico's Energy Transition Act: the law designed to move this state away from exactly the kind of energy you're planning to use.

You told county commissioners to approve \$165 billion in bonds the same day or you'd leave. They did. Residents shouted "Recall" from the audience. That's not a community welcoming you. That's a community that was given no choice.

Doña Ana County has colonias without paved roads. One in four children lives in poverty. You're offering \$360 million in tax payments spread over 30 years against a \$165 billion investment. You can do the math on what that's worth.

This is the wrong project in the wrong place, and the people who live there know it.

Shame on you. Whoever you are reading this, you're a part of the problem. Quit your job. You are an asshole.
