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Data centers in our community are not welcome. It is destroying the environment, and will be especially hurtful to our delicate community living in a desert. This is not acceptable, and will destroy wildlife. This will also hurt the health of ALL New Mexicans. The public should receive at least 60 days to review. Bloom's air quality permit needs to be denied due to its history of waste dumping. If the permit is not denied, there should be a English/Spanish hearing in Santa Teresa. This permit would be government sponsored environmental racism. Doña Ana county already faces subpar air quality, and is disproportionately affected by environmental pollution.
