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Project Jupiter in Doña Ana County poses significant environmental and public health risks that warrant a denial of its air permit application. The proposed industrial activities are likely to introduce elevated levels of particulate matter, nitrogen oxides, and volatile organic compounds into the atmosphere, directly compromising air quality for residents and contributing to respiratory illnesses. Furthermore, the increased industrial footprint threatens the delicate desert ecosystem, disrupting habitats for indigenous wildlife and potentially contaminating vital water sources through atmospheric deposition. Granting this permit would not only undermine the health and well-being of the local community but also set a dangerous precedent for industrial development in environmentally sensitive areas, neglecting the long-term ecological and social costs.
