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Communities and our earth shouldn't be put at risk just for something that humans have been living without for years. Ai data centers shouldn't be prioritized over the wellbeing of the people people and other living things in the planet. Why should people risk their communities and basic things like water just for the benefit of billionaires? While billionaires have money to be able to live without worry in this inevitable climate change there are many people who lose their homes and animals who die and are going into extinction. Ai data centers shouldn't be a priority and a necessity when basic things like water, clean air and species who keep our ecosystems functioning are put in a high risk.

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
