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Project Jupiter's power plant will release up to 10 million tons of climate-warming greenhouse gasses every year. This will effect the health of many that living in the area not to mention the crops that will no be able to be produced to help feed people. The Chihuahuan Desert borderlands are not a barren dump site for Bloom Technologies to test their experimental technologies. The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably. The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County. If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
