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Dear NMED staff, My name is Faye, I am submitting this comment to urge the New Mexico Environment Department to reject Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid in Doña Ana County. The project's new proposed fuel cell powered grid is still concerning and doesn't change the risks for many reasons: * This technology generates toxic waste, and the process for handling this waste is still unclear. * Fuel cell technology or a centralized waste system has never occurred at this scale. * Surrounding community air will be negatively impacted by this development. * It would still produce a high level of greenhouse gas and toxic pollutants. I would also like add that NMED should give the public 60 days of additional time to review and comment on the Application to ensure everyone can meaningfully comment and participate. Again, I urge the NMED to outright reject YUCCA Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid. And, I ask the department to please hold a bilingual public hearing near the Santa Teresa community, so that residents can learn about the risks associated with fuel cell technology. Sincerely, Faye
