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The construction of an AI data center in our area will have a clear and tangible negative impact on water availability, air quality, noise pollution, and local ecosystems. While I recognize that sacrifices to these systems can be justified, I see no way in which this project will provide any real benefit to our local community, the country, or the world. Any financial investment in our area is, in my opinion, far outweighed by the reduction quality of life for people and wildlife, and the destruction of natural lands that similar projects have demonstrably caused wherever they are undertaken. Furthermore, this project is wildly unpopular within the local community, as I'm sure has already been made clear to city councillors and other local policymakers. These policymakers have an obligation to represent the interests of their constituents over corporate interests or their own financial gain. I strongly oppose any process that will allow this project to continue, and I hope that local officials will fulfill their duty of acting in the interests of the general public and prevent this project from being completed.
